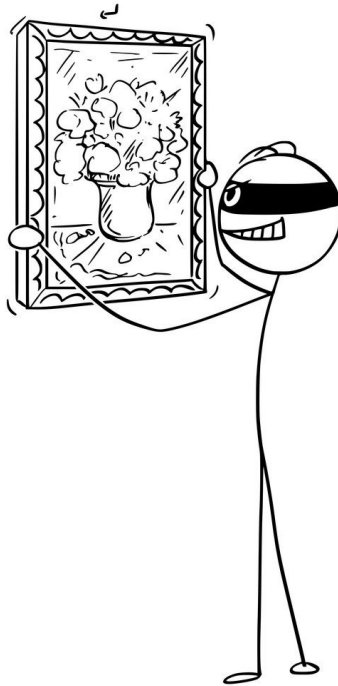

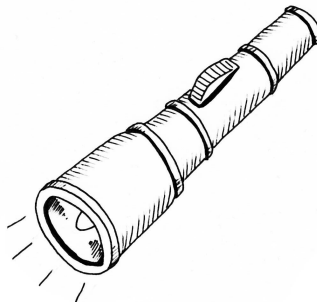

Jetta Young: (Design Crew) This is Jetta's first production with the Drama Club, and she looks forward to many more during her time here at GCHS.



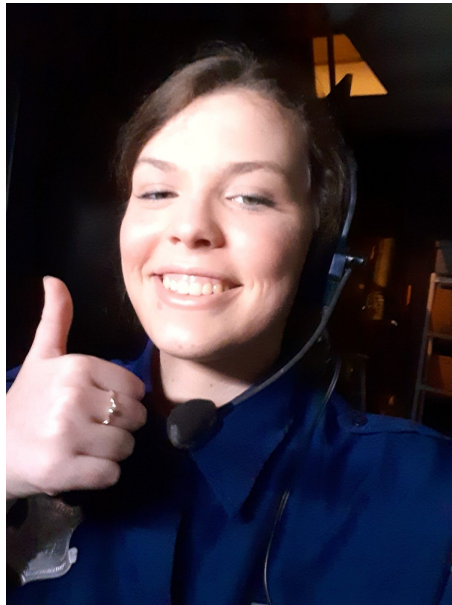
