## Captain Shreve Highline Tryouts General Information

We are pleased and excited that you are interested in trying out for the Captain Shreve Highline. A <u>mandatory</u> dance clinic has been scheduled for Tuesday, March 2nd 4:00-5:30, Wednesday, March 3rd 4:00-5:30, and Thursday, March 4th 4:00-5:30 in the Cafeteria for those interested in trying out for the Highline. During this time, candidates will learn and perform the necessary skills required for the tryout. The tryout will be Friday, March 5th starting promptly at 4:00 in the gymnasium.

Tryouts for membership to the dance line are open to any qualifying students entering the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Each participant is responsible for transportation from the clinic and tryouts. If a candidate is absent during ANY POINT of the clinic, he/she will be unable to tryout with **no reimbursement of the \$25 tryout fee**. If a candidate is not picked up within **15 minutes** of dismissal time, he/she will automatically be dismissed from the clinic and tryouts with **no reimbursement of the \$25 tryout fee**. On the day of tryouts, it is required that everyone trying out wear all black clothing that permits movement such as a black t-shirt and shorts (no jeans, etc.). No excessive baggy clothing may be worn. Clothing cannot be Shreve or dance affiliated. Tennis or dance shoes during tryouts are required. NO dancing in socks or barefoot. If for any reason you do not have these items, make arrangements to borrow them. There will be no exceptions the day of tryouts. Hair must also be worn in a ponytail and absolutely no jewelry.

The clinic and tryouts are closed. For those unfamiliar with this term, this means that administrators, judges, score tabulators, Highline coach/sponsors, and candidates will only be allowed in the gym for clinic and tryouts. Parents and other students will not be allowed to view the tryouts/clinic in any way. No recording device will be allowed in the clinic or tryouts. Please do not ask for an exception. The selection of the Highline will not be posted until the evening of Friday, March 5th.

If for any reason you are not able to follow these rules, the Shreve Highline is not for you. We will be working very hard from this point on and we will require your full commitment. Please consider all of these stipulations along with the required camp, practice, and event dates before you decide to tryout.

<u>Fees</u>: Participation as a member of the Highline is \$1850 as there are costs for uniforms, camp, and payment towards other activities such as competition. **This fee OR any portion of it is NOT REFUNDABLE for any reason.** The fee may be divided into 4 payments. 1st payment (\$500) is due Tuesday, March 23rd; 2nd payment (\$450) is due Tuesday, April 13th; 3rd payment (\$450) is due Tuesday, May 4th; and the 4th and final payment (\$450) is due Tuesday, May 18th.

Tryout packets and the fee for tryouts are due by Thursday, February 25th to Mrs. Wilson (A102). The <u>mandatory parent meeting</u> is Thursday, February 18th in the cafeteria from 6:00 to approximately 6:45. If parents do not attend the meeting and the packet with tryout fee are not turned in by February 25th, the candidate will not be allowed to attend the clinic and/or tryout. If you do not attend any and all designated clinic days you will also be unable to tryout and the *tryout fee will not be refunded*.

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CAPTAIN SHREVE HIGH SCHOOL SPIRIT GROUPS (Varsity Cheerleaders/Mascot, Highline, Junior Varsity Cheerleaders, Flagline, Majorettes, Freshman Cheerleaders and Pep Squad) Revised January 2021

## I. Purpose

- A. Serve the school by promoting school spirit and serving in any capacity that might reflect a positive image of our school
- B. Develop character by building qualities such as leadership, cooperation, sportsmanship, honesty, scholarship, and confidence; and exhibit such qualities in the group's image of high standards of conduct
- C. Cultivate cooperation within the squad and with other spirit groups
- D. Develop dance/cheer abilities by learning dance routines/techniques and cheers/techniques in order to provide entertainment at school and community events
- E. Reach out to our community in a variety of ways
- II. Membership Selection
  - A. Tryouts:
    - a. Flagline/Highline/Varsity Cheerleader/Mascot/JV Cheerleader/Majorette Tryouts will be held in the spring semester of each year. Freshman Cheer will be held in August (prior to school starting).
    - b. Candidates must be currently enrolled in Captain Shreve High School in order to try out.
    - c. Candidates must be entering the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade the next school year in order to be eligible for JV Cheer and Flagline. Candidates must be entering the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade for Varsity Cheer. Entering 9<sup>th</sup> graders are eligible to try out for Highline, Majorettes, and Freshman Cheer.
    - d. The parent/guardian must attend a mandatory parent meeting in order to try out.
    - e. A candidate must attend all clinic sessions. See sponsor with questions.
    - f. No recording devices will be allowed during the clinic and tryouts with the exception of Freshman Cheer.
    - g. Candidates must be present 3 hours at school to participate in the clinic for that day.
    - h. Candidates must submit a non-refundable tryout fee with the signed tryout packet forms to the sponsor by the specified deadline. The tryout fee will be used to pay judging and instructional fees.
    - i. Grade point average of 2.0 (as shown on the semester report card) must be established and maintained as directed by the requirements of the Caddo Parish School Board.
    - j. A candidate may try out with administrative approval concerning discipline matters.

- k. Each candidate must be a current member of a spirit group, JROTC, band or an athletic program.
- 1. All school-related fees and debts must be paid before candidates can try out.
- m. A candidate will need shorts, t-shirts, and tennis shoes for the clinic. For tryouts, they will need an outfit of the sponsor's discretion with no cheer or dance logos.
- n. The candidates will try out in small groups before a panel of judges.
- o. Clinic and tryouts will be closed.
- B. Scoring
  - a. Candidates scores are based on a combination of averaged judges' scores (70%), averaged teacher recommendations received (20%), and current sponsor recommendation (10%) with the exception of freshmen cheer which will be 100% averaged judges' scores. All spirit groups with the exception of Pep Squad will be selected via a natural break in final tryout scores.
  - b. A mascot will be chosen by displaying creativity, spirit, and crowd involvement during tryouts.
  - c. Score sheets will be tallied by two auditors approved by the administrators.
  - d. The final list will be approved by an administrator prior to posting the list. The list will be posted on the front doors of the school and/or through social media. All decisions are FINAL!
- III. Membership Requirements
  - A. Member Rules
    - a. Membership of all CSHS spirit groups is for one year from the date of selection. Members must try out/sign up each year.
    - b. Members must be skilled in appropriate spirit group activities.
    - c. Each member must be capable of purchasing practice and performance uniforms. Uniforms and practice uniforms may be worn only by current members. All props, travel expenses, and camp fees are to be paid by each member. Fundraisers will be conducted for any type of special event funding, such as competitions. All deadlines for such fees must be met in accordance with sponsor requirements.
    - d. Once a financial commitment has been made to a spirit group, no refund will be issued.
    - e. Members are to have all uniforms paid for by the due dates in order to participate in camp and upcoming school activities.
    - f. Grade point average must be maintained at 2.0 and no Fs (as seen on the report card) as directed by CPSB policy. Grade point averages will be checked at the end of each semester. If an 'F' appears on a report card or progress report, parent and student must arrange and attend a parent/teacher conference before the student is allowed to resume performing with the team.
    - g. All Varsity Cheerleaders, JV Cheerleaders, Freshmen Cheerleaders, Highline, Majorettes and Flagline members will need to get a physical prior to the beginning of the season. Sponsors will keep these forms.
    - h. All Spirit Group members will need to fill out a permission slip, field trip form, and medical documents.
    - i. Members must be prepared to practice after school and/or before school, be present for scheduled practices during the summer, and to attend camp. Spirit

groups attend all football games, basketball games, postseason and/or playoff games, and other designated events. Attendance is mandatory and failure to participate will result in demerits. Work is not an excused absence. Participating in a non-Shreve affiliated performing group is also not an excused absence.

- j. All Spirit Groups are part of promoting school spirit. This includes cheering at all required activities, as appropriate, and positive attitudes during all performances.
- k. Demerits will not start over at any point.
- 1. Members must be in school for 3 hours to participate in mandatory spirit group activities.
- m. If a member is unable to practice due to minor injury or illness, attendance at practice and games in full uniform is still required.
- n. All off-campus spirit activities are school sponsored and members must apply all school rules and policies.
- o. All spirit group members must ride the bus to all necessary games/events. Parents may pick up their members from an event with a written note that should be turned in the day before the trip by 12:00 PM.
- p. All members must participate in all fundraising activities or be prepared to make an equivalent financial contribution to the spirit group's account.
- q. If a member has an F in a class, she/he will not be able to attend field trips that require her/him to miss class.
- r. Banner making, poster making, candy bag assembly, spirit breakfast decorating, community service projects, locker room decorating, fundraising, and any other spirit group activity designated by the sponsor will be required activities for all spirit groups.
- B. Code of Conduct
  - a. All spirit group members will be expected to adhere to the Captain Shreve Code of Conduct which states:
    - i. Conduct yourself at all times according to high personal standards. Members should be conscious of their social media conduct including but not limited to: texting, Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, SnapChat, etc.
    - ii. Be honest, kind, respectful, and helpful to others.
    - iii. Follow all school rules.
    - iv. Adhere to all policies found in the Captain Shreve Student Handbook and the Caddo Parish Student Handbook.
- C. Officer Selection
  - a. Officer Selection will be based on tryout score and leadership ability as defined in the Officer Tryout packet specific to each spirit group.
  - b. A candidate must have no more than 5 demerits to be considered for an officer position.
  - c. If an officer accumulates 10 demerits at any time throughout the year, she will be dismissed from her officer duties and title.
  - d. Spirit groups will have a captain and co-captain.
    - i. For Varsity Cheer, JV Cheer, Highline, and Flagline, the Captain and Co-Captain will be selected based on an audition process stated in the tryout information packet.

- 1. The Captain for Varsity Cheer shall be a Senior.
- ii. Captain and Co-Captain for Pep Squad and Freshman Cheer will be selected by the Sponsor after member review during practices.
- D. Duties of Captain and Co-Captain(s) for Freshman, JV, Varsity Cheer, Highline, and Flagline
  - a. The chain of command is: Co-Captain, Captain, Sponsor.
  - b. Be at practice before starting time and have the practice start on time.
  - c. Lead squad in a warm-up routine.
  - d. Recommend to the sponsor/coach any additional practices as deemed necessary.
  - e. Notify the squad if the scheduled time or date is changed.
  - f. Be responsible for the use of **appropriate** cheer, chant, dance, and music for all routines.
  - g. Lead the squad onto the court for timeouts and halftime performances.
  - h. Design all routines for pep rallies including open house and all-squad routines.
  - i. Designate the proper uniform to be worn for each event pending sponsor approval prior to the day of the event.
  - j. Perform duties mentioned in the Captain and Co-Captain application packet.
- E. Spirit Group Class Expectations
  - a. A member is required to dress out daily and participate.
- F. Medical Release
  - a. All spirit group members must provide a medical release form from a licensed medical doctor or certified athletic trainer to return to practice or competition after an injury or at any time deemed by the sponsor.
- IV. Demerits
  - A. Monthly demerit notifications will be given to the spirit group member by the sponsor or co-sponsor with the expectation that it will be delivered to the parent.
  - B. When a member accumulates 10 demerits (with the exception of pep squad which will be 15 demerits), they will be placed on probation and will not perform the routine/cheer at the game/performance of choice by the sponsor. A notification letter will be sent to inform parents/guardians and the spirit group member of the infractions that led to probation.
  - C. Demerits will not start over at the beginning of the second semester.
  - D. Any member receiving 20 demerits will forfeit their membership from the team for the remainder of the year (with the exception of pep squad which will be dismissed at 25 demerits).
  - E. Once a member has been dismissed from the team, the member will not be allowed to wear any part of the CSHS Spirit group uniform (performance uniforms, practice uniforms, athletic jacket, or any other part of the spirit group wardrobe).

The following is a list of violations that will result in the designated demerits. Any officer may report violations, but the **sponsor makes the final decision** regarding the giving of demerits.

## V. Performance Requirements

- A. A member who is absent 2 practices prior to performance may not be allowed to perform at the discretion of the sponsor.
- B. A member who has not demonstrated proficiency in the routine will not be allowed to perform. Members must be present at practice on the designated evaluation day. Cuts may be made prior to each performance.
- C. Members must be present at school at least 3 hours of the school day on the day of a game or performance to be eligible to perform.
- D. Members must be in complete uniform as designated by the sponsor or they will not be allowed to perform.

- a. Hair color must be natural. Hair style must be conducive to uniformity, and versatile enough to change styles easily according to the sponsor(s) discretion.
- b. Enhancements to appearance (ie. eyelashes, piercings, etc) must not interfere with practices/performances and at the sponsor(s) discretion.
- c. Excessive fingernail length will not be allowed. The length should not present a chance of injury to other team members. Nail color should be neutral, clear, or approved by the sponsor prior to.
- d. Tattoos will be covered with makeup or neutral-colored bandages if they show outside the given uniform.
- e. If uniform needs to be replaced due to inappropriateness, misplacement, damage, theft, etc., members will receive demerits for the initial infraction, and will sit out from any and all future performances, games, or events until it is replaced by the member and/or parent/guardian.
- VI. Probation/Dismissal
  - A. Any member who is in violation of the following governing regulations will face probation or dismissal from membership of the CSHS Spirit groups. They are not allowed to wear any part of the spirit group uniform during probation / after dismissal. No refunds will be issued upon dismissal.
    - a. Accumulation of 20 demerits (with the exception of pep squad which will be dismissed at 25 demerits)
    - b. Suspension as imposed by CPSB Discipline Policy
    - c. Breaking any school rule or spirit group rule while in any part of the CSHS spirit group uniform
    - d. Not maintaining the required GPA
  - B. Probation/Dismissal will be administered by the sponsor and administration and a parent will be contacted.
