Early Childhood Screening

Minnesota state law requires that all children be screened before entering public kindergarten. Early Childhood Screening examines young children's hearing, vision, immunizations, coordination, speech, cognitive development, and social and emotional skills. The early childhood years from birth to the start of kindergarten are an important time of rapid learning and growth. Screening is a brief, simple procedure used to identify potential health or developmental problems in young children who may need a health assessment, diagnostic assessment or educational evaluation. If your child is between the ages of 3-5 and has not been screened, we will be contacting you in April with Screening information.
