- Use specific strategies and procedures for building relationships and sharing control to prevent a vast majority of negative behaviors while creating a calm, safe environment;
- > Avoid demands and threats by replacing them with Gentle Guidance Interventions; and
- Use Procedural and Delayed Learning Opportunities to teach positive behaviors on your terms without anger or punishment

Training Focus: Day #1:

Staff will learn <u>relationship building strategies</u>. For example, setting up a classroom that creates a collaborative and safe learning environment for all students, setting up the classroom as a clubhouse with teams, greeting each student with an ESPN greeting, supporting students in the development of student-created class rules, etc.

Training Focus: Day # 2:

Staff will learn <u>control sharing strategies</u> for sharing control on the adult's terms rather than on the student's terms.

Training Focus: Day #3:

Staff will learn <u>strategies</u> that they can begin to <u>implement immediately</u>. For example, implementing the argument shield, strategic noticing; calm signal, preventive movement, 42 gentle guidance interventions, delayed learning opportunities.
