- Students are required to notify the office if they drive a vehicle that is not registered on their permit.
- Irresponsible driving on the school lot, not yielding to school bus traffic, parking in other parking spaces, chronic absenteeism or tardiness, and/or a disciplinary record may revoke this permit.

Parking permit sales will open at 9:00 a.m. on the following schedule:

Seniors - July 27

Seniors and Juniors – July 28

All grades – July 29 and beyond

NEW THIS YEAR:

- 1. Students will choose two preferred parking zones. Zones are noted on the parking map and are as follows:
 - a. Zone 1 Spots 1-36 (the traditional senior parking lot cars only)
 - b. Zone 2 Spots 37-141 (center of the main lot cars only)
 - c. Zone 3 Spots 145-164 (trucks only back row)
 - d. Zone 4 Spots 165-195 (trucks only front row)
- 2. The car only zones will be enforced. If your primary vehicle is a truck, you must park in the truck zones.
- 3. Each purchase on local level is assigned a ticket # THIS IS NOT YOUR PARKING SPOT
- 4. Parking assignments will be issued by the office staff according to your Local Level Ticket # and your zone preference.

Process to obtain a parking pass:

- All sales will be conducted online.
- Visit the Local Level Events site to start the permit process.
 - The link will not be live until July 27 at 9:00 a.m.
- Each student is permitted to purchase ONE parking permit through the Local Level Online Sales System. The student will use their student ID (lunch number) to purchase on July 27 and 28.
 Starting July 29, no ID number will be required.
- You must have your car license plate number, your driver's license number* and your insurance information to enter into the Local Level System. **Be sure to have it on hand when you start the process.**

*Student must possess a valid driver's license. (No student may be issued a parking permit on their learner's permit.)

- Once school starts, students should park *only in their assigned spot*.
- To be issued their validated parking hang tag, the student must present the following items to the cashier:
 - A completed Parking Permit Application
 - Their driver's license
- No vehicle will be permitted on the school lot without the permit after September 11, 2023.
