## **GUEST POLICIES**

- Only one guest per Westerville South student permitted.
- Photo identification is needed by all guests.
- Guests must meet the following age criteria:
  - 1. High school student in grades 9-12;
  - 2. If not enrolled in a high school, may be no older than 20 years of age.
- Guests must follow the Westerville City Schools Code of Conduct.
- No guest will be admitted the night of the dance without this form being on file.
- If there are any problems, both the Westerville South High School student and guest will be removed from the dance.
- Once the guest or Westerville South High School student leave the event, he/she will not be allowed to return.
- Guest must arrive and depart with the student.

## **DANCE POLICIES**

Inappropriate Dancing will not be permitted. The definition of Inappropriate Dancing is any or all dancing that is found to be "sexually suggestive or dangerous in any way." Examples of this include but are not limited to:

- Any inappropriate or vulgar backside dancing (ankle/knee grabbing, bending over more that 90 degrees, hands on the floor, etc.)
- Inappropriate touching, fondling, or excessive displays of affection
- On the floor or lap dancing
- Violent "mosh pit" style dancing
