Parking Permit Policies:

- Students are required to notify the office if they drive a vehicle that is not registered on their permit.
- Irresponsible driving on the school lot, not yielding to school bus traffic, parking in other parking spaces, chronic absenteeism or tardiness, and/or a disciplinary record may revoke this permit.
- The parking permit shall be located on the backside of the rearview mirror of each vehicle at all times.
- Once school starts, students should only park in their assigned spot.
- Students may not move vehicles during school hours.
- No vehicle will be permitted on the school lot without the permit after September 2, 2025.
- Replacement tags will cost \$1.00.

2025-2026 Parking Permit Sales

Parking Permit sales will open at 8:00 am on the following schedule:

Seniors: July 22, 2025 Seniors and Juniors: July 23, 2025 All Grades: July 24, 2025 and beyond

- 1. Visit Local Level Events and search Fairfield Union High School 2025-2026 Parking Permit Sale. *NOTE: This link is not live until July 22nd*.
- 2. Each student is permitted to purchase ONE parking permit through Local Level. The student will use their student ID (lunch number) to purchase on July 22nd and July 23rd. Before beginning Local Level, be sure you have your license plate number, your driver's license number, and your insurance policy information. This is needed to complete the required information. ALL students must possess a valid driver's license. (No student will be issued a parking permit on their learner's permit.)
- 3. Students will choose 2 preferred parking zones. Zones are noted on the parking map and are as follows:
 - a. Zone 1 Spots 1 36 (traditional Senior parking lot cars only)
 - b. Zone 2 Spots 37 141 (center of the main student lot cars only)
 - c. Zone 3 Spots 145-164 (trucks only back field side)
 - d. Zone 4 Spots 165 195 (trucks only front road side)

(The car only zones are enforced. If your primary vehicle is a truck, you must park in a truck zone.)

- 4. Each purchase on Local Level is assigned a ticket #. THIS IS NOT YOUR PARKING SPOT.
- 5. Once school starts, students shall only park in their assigned parking spot.
- 6. To be issued their validated hang-tag, students must present this completed form and their driver's license to the cashier in the HS office. Parking assignments will be issued by the office staff according to your Local Level Ticket # and your zone preference.
- 7. No vehicle will be permitted on school property without the hang-tag permit after 09/02/25.
