Found in 1951, Babe Ruth Baseball League was created for ballplayers age 13-15 who wished to continue their baseball playing experience beyond the age of 12. This is where players get their baseball cleats muddy for the first time on standard 90' diamonds under Official Baseball Rules used by Major League.

Age Requirement: Any player born prior to May 1, 2005 and on or after May 1, 2002 will be eligible for Babe Ruth 13-15 League Competition.

Babe Ruth season starts early June and ends in July. Games will be played on Mondays & Wednesday nights 5:30pm (Double Headers) Practices schedule TBA.

Player Code of Ethics

As a member of the Nevis Summer Baseball & Softball Program, I represent my family, my school, my community and most importantly, myself as a player. It is my job to work hard to always show good Sportsmanship. I will:

Learn and keep the rules set by my league and my team.

Keep a positive attitude towards all my Nevis teammates!

We are one team – the NEVIS team – Be respectful of all.

Keep my temper, and respect the umpires, coaches & my opponents.

Keep myself fit and ready to play. This includes getting enough sleep before a game, eating before I come (or bringing a bag meal), and always bringing my water bottle with me to every practice and game.

Care for my uniform, and make sure I wear my uniform pants, shirt and hat to every game so I can participate.
This is my responsibility - not my parents!

Show consideration for my coach by always letting the team manager know in advance if I am going to be gone from a practice or game night.

Talk to my coach if I have a concern. And listen to my coach when he or she is talking to me too. Don't assume your coach knows your concerns – talk to them!

Remember safety comes first. Always wearing a batting helmet when out of the dug out while batting or on deck.
If I ever get hurt, I will tell the coach.

Being respectful of dugout rules when I am not up to bat or on the line up.

Be polite – remember to thank those who give you rides and help each night. Without them you would not have baseball fun!

Show good sportsmanship values every game –

“Lose without excuses and to win without boasting.”

I understand that I am responsible for properly disposing of any trash that I leave at the fields, the dugout and in the stands! I will leave the field better than I find it.

Parents' Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in Nevis Baseball & Softball by following this Parent Code of Ethics.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other Nevis program event.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child, and other's children, ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe, healthy and positive environment.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable learning experience for all.

I will be responsible for my child's transportation to and from practice and games. If I cannot do this myself, I will advise the team manager ahead of game time of arrangements made for my child.

I will assist my child in arriving prepared each day – in full uniform, **with a water bottle**, and to **be on time**.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco alcohol and inappropriate language and will refrain from their use at all League events.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I understand that the primary objective of Nevis Baseball is not the win/loss record of my child's team or the position my child plays but rather to teach teamwork, sportsmanship and the fundamentals of baseball in a positive learning environment.

I recognize that games will be officiated by community members and volunteers. And just as I may not agree with decisions reached by major league umpires, I understand and accept that I may not always agree with officiating decisions at my child's games.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. I will assist where needed to help the Nevis program benefit all children, be this with transportation needs, fund raising, or general encouragement for all players and coaches in the Nevis program.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability. I will respect the league rules, and assure my child is respectful of the rules also.

I will help with grounds clean up after each game, including properly disposing of trash, and will ensure that my child does the same.
