AI Unplugged for Early Grades



*Hands-on activities that help young learners
understand how AI works.
No student devices required!*

Young children are naturally curious about how technology “thinks.” This session helps educators introduce AI in ways that build foundational understanding, but without student devices. Instead, we will focus on computational and critical thinking skills without the use of devices. Specifically, we will look at:

- How to teach AI concepts using unplugged activities from ReadyAI
- Whole-class prompting routines where the teacher drives the AI
- Activities that build understanding of patterns, training data, and decision-making
- Ways to connect AI ideas to literacy, math, SEL, and inquiry
- Strategies for keeping early-grade AI learning safe, fun, and concrete
