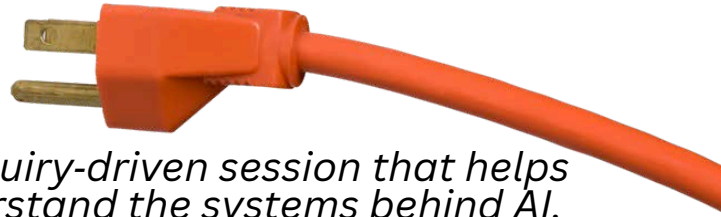

AI Unplugged for High School



*A practical, inquiry-driven session that helps
students understand the systems behind AI.
No student devices required!*

High school students are already encountering AI in academics, media, and daily life. This session equips educators with concrete ways to help teens understand how AI systems function, question their outputs, and use them responsibly. You will walk away with:

- A clear overview of key AI concepts for grades 9–12
- Demonstrations of unplugged simulations (classification, training, feedback loops)

- Small-group problem-solving and critique activities
