Using AI with Your Early Grade Students



*Safe, simple, teacher-led ways to explore
AI with young learners*

Young learners are naturally curious about technology, but they aren't necessarily ready to use AI on their own. Pre-K-3 students need guided, developmentally appropriate experiences. This session helps educators introduce AI in ways that are safe, collaborative, and rooted in early-childhood best practices. Specifically, we will cover:

- What safe, age-appropriate AI use looks like for young children
- How to structure teacher-led prompting while students watch and contribute
- Small-group routines that keep students engaged without individual devices
- How to model curiosity, questioning, and critical thinking
- Strategies for protecting student privacy and maintaining safe boundaries
- Examples of literacy, SEL, and inquiry activities enhanced by AI
