# Using AI with Your High School Students

*Helping teens use AI independently,  
responsibly, and transparently*

Many high-school students are already using AI in and out of school, but that doesn't mean they don't still need clear expectations, supervision, and ethical grounding. This session helps educators walk through the process of setting clear AI boundaries and expectations with their students. Additionally, we will look at:

- What responsible AI use looks like for high-school learners
- How to teach transparent, ethical AI use in academic work
- Routines for helping students document and explain their AI assistance
- Strategies for preventing over-reliance, plagiarism, and misuse
- How to coach students to critique, verify, and refine AI outputs
