

2026-2027 Student Parking Permit Sales

Gold, Silver, and Bronze status students will be notified of their AAA +1 Status for the 1st semester of the 2026-2027 School Year on or before July 24, 2026 and will include a parking discount code.

All students will be permitted to purchase their parking permits on Local Level Events beginning July 27, 2026.

Seniors may come to the HS office to select their qualifying parking spot on Tuesday and Wednesday, **08/04 & 08/05.**

Juniors may come to the HS office to select their qualifying parking spot on Thursday and Friday, **08/06 & 08/07.**

All other grades may come to the HS office to select their qualifying spot beginning Monday, **08/10 and beyond.**

1. Visit Local Level Events and search Fairfield Union High School 2026-2027 Parking Permit Sale.
NOTE: This sale is not open prior to July 27th.
2. Each student is permitted to purchase ONE parking permit through Local Level. AAA + 1 Status Students will use the discount code emailed to their student email account to apply the discount. All students will use their student ID (lunch number) to purchase tickets beginning on the date listed above. Before beginning your Local Level Events entry, be sure you have your license plate number, your driver's license number, and your insurance policy information. This is needed to complete the required information. ALL students must possess a valid driver's license. (No student will be issued a parking permit on their learner's permit.)
3. Students will be permitted to select their parking spots based on AAA +1 Status and their anticipated class schedule for the school year. *PLEASE NOTE: Your parking spot may need to change based on your final schedule.* Spots are issued on a first come, first served basis.
4. Each purchase on Local Level is assigned a ticket number. **THIS IS NOT YOUR PARKING SPOT.**
5. You may bring your completed paper to the HS office along with your driver's license and insurance card and pick up your hang tag according to the above dates. YOU MUST BRING THESE DOCUMENTS TO RECEIVE THE HANG TAG.
6. **Hang tags will also be available for pick up at the HS Open House on August 13th.**
7. Once school starts, students shall only park in their assigned parking spot.
8. No vehicle will be permitted on school property without the hang-tag permit after 08/24/26.

2. You may present this completed form, a valid driver's license, and your insurance card to the cashier to pick up your hang-tag according to the schedule on the back of this form.
3. Your hang-tag must be hanging from the rearview mirror with the number visible from the outside of the vehicle.

Parking Permit Policies:

- Students are required to notify the office if they drive a vehicle that is not listed on this paper as their primary or secondary vehicle.
- Irresponsible driving on the school lot, not yielding to school bus traffic, parking in other parking spaces, chronic absenteeism or tardiness, and/or a disciplinary record may revoke this permit.
- The parking permit hang-tag shall be located on the backside of the review mirror of each vehicle at all times.
- Once school starts, students should only park in their assigned spot.
- No vehicle will be permitted on the school parking lots without the permit after August 24, 2026.
- Replacement tags will incur a fee of \$1.00
