DRESS CODE

- 1. STUDENTS MUST WEAR CLOTHING THAT IS SEMI-FORMAL AND APPROPRIATE.
- 2. If a student's attire does not comply with the said dress code, he or she will be denied admittance to the dance. Parents will be notified and the student will be sent home.
- 3. Inappropriate attire includes, but is not limited to, jeans, t-shirts, sweatshirts, and sweatpants.

TICKET SALES

- Tickets MUST be purchased in advance online at <u>www.locallevelevents.com</u> by Friday, May 10. Absolutely NO tickets will be sold at the door for the dance.
- 2. Students who arrive at the dance without a pre-purchased ticket will be denied entry.
- 3. Only the original purchaser of the ticket can use the ticket. Tickets cannot be resold or given to other students.
- 4. Ticket sale begins on Monday, April 8. Tickets will cost \$50 per person.

ATTENDEES

- 1. Only students who are **currently in high school or 2018 graduates** are allowed into the dance.
- 2. Students who will be attending as guests from other schools will be required to complete an information form that includes parental/emergency contact information, parent signature, as well as the signature of one of the guest's school administrators.
- 3. Completed information forms must be turned in when tickets are purchased.

ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICY

- 1. No student under the influence of alcohol or any other illegal substance will be granted admission to the dance.
- 2. Any student who chooses to violate this code may face disciplinary action from the administration and law enforcement.

APPROPRIATE DANCING

- 1. This is a school dance and your behavior should be appropriate.
- 2. Dancing that is overly suggestive i.e. excessive touching, fondling, and/or excessive displays of affection will not be permitted.
- 3. No violent or "mosh pit" style dancing is permitted.
