Camp One (2 weeks): June 15 - June 26

Registration Fee: \$30 (due at time of registration—nonrefundable)

Camp 1 Tuition Fee: \$350 (due 30 days prior to camp start date)

Camp Theme: Camp NEST

This two-week camp will offer a variety of opportunities for children to explore nature and become a member of Camp NEST. We will keep the campers engaged with crafts and art projects using materials from the great outdoors. During this camp, students will have several excursions off site to fully experience our theme. Students will travel to Vermillion River Reservation where students will enjoy a nature hike and pan for gold (weather and river height permitting). We will conclude our camp with a field trip to the Cleveland Botanical Gardens on June 26th where students will enjoy a special workshop on plants and then explore the gardens.

Camp Two (4 days): June 29 – July 2 (We will be CLOSED July 3rd)

Registration Fee: \$20 (due at time of registration—nonrefundable)

Camp 2 Tuition Fee: \$160 (due 30 days prior to camp start date)

Camp Theme: America the Beautiful

Students will begin the week by making a patriotic shirt (shirts included in price of camp) that they will want to wear on Thursday, July 2 when we travel to Progressive Field for a Cleveland Indians game! Registration Fee: \$25 (due at time of registration—nonrefundable)
